NOTEBOOK IMPRESSES WITH CRADDOCKSTOWN WIN

Henry de Bromhead saddled the first two home in the previous race, the Gr.2 Craddockstown Novice Chase.

Mount Pelier (Milan) made much of the running in the 2m event until he was headed four out by de Bromhead's Germanbred Notebook (Samum) and the favourite Eclair De Beaufeu (Monitor Closely) from the Gordon Elliott team. Notebook took a clear advantage at the second-last and stayed on well from that point to win by five lengths, with stablemate Moon Over Germany (Germany) running on late to take second from the rallying Mount Pelier.

The winner, bred by Gestut Am Schlossgarten, had won one of his three runs in point-to-points when he was bought by Mags O'Toole for £70,000 at the 2016 Tattersalls Cheltenham May Sale. Since then, he has won over hurdles and finished second at Gr.3 level, and started his chasing career with a victory over **Eclair De Beaufeu** on this course last month.

The winning trainer told reporters: "He looked impressive here the last day and it's nice to see him back it up. His jumping was great; he seems to love it. He's really exciting and the fences make a big difference to him. He jumps quick and I think we should use that over two miles for the moment.
