new connections have had to be very patient with him, as he did not appear for 1,089 days before winning a Naas beginners chase by 31 lengths last March. He then won the Gr.1 Ryanair Novice Chase in May but was not seen again until coming second to **A Plus Tard** over this course and distance during the Christmas period.

Chacun Pour Soi is by the multiple Gr.2-winning **Sadler's Wells** stallion **Policy Maker**, who has been standing at Blackrath Stud in Ireland for the last four seasons, and was bred by Didier Berland. His dam **Kruscyna** (**Ultimately Lucky**) won the 2007 Gr.3 Prix Bournosienne, an Auteuil hurdles contest for three-year-old fillies, and was also successful over fences. The dam of a subsequent bumper winner by **Kap Rock**, she is the only winner out of her dam and the third dam is a full-sister to Flat Stakes winners **Pharako** and **Melambo** (**Montevideo**).

NOTEBOOK DOWNS CASH BACK IN ARKLE NOVICE CHASE

The Gr.1 Arkle Novice Chase also had a leading contender, Joseph O'Brien's **Fakir D'Oudairies**, drop out due to the drying ground, but, like the Gr.1 Dublin Chase previously, it still had a star winner in Henry de Bromhead's **Notebook**.

The seven-year-old son of **Samum**, who had bolted to the start with Rachael Blackmore, raced in third as **Cash Back** (**Linda's Lad**) jumped out in front and soon opened up a three-length lead. There was little change in the order until the closing stages whereby **Notebook** and **Cash Back** had gone five lengths clear of **Melon** in third. **Notebook** jumped his way to the front with a

fine leap at the penultimate fence and he and **Cash Back** rounded the turn together, sparking a roar from the crowd. They raced down to the last and took it in unison, but **Notebook** found that bit extra on the run on to score by three quarters of a length. **Gallant John Joe** (**Presenting**) made good ground from the back to take third, seven lengths adrift of **Cash Back**.

A point-to-point winner on his third attempt, **Notebook** was a fair hurdler, winning a maiden and coming second in a Gr.3, but he has improved immeasurably since returning to the larger obstacles. He has now won all four chase starts, which include the Gr.2 Craddockstown Novice Chase and a Gr.1 here on St Stephen's Day.

Bred by Gestut Am Schlossgarten in Germany, he is a half-brother to the Italian Listed winner **Nebukadnezar** (**Lomitas**), out of the Listed-placed **Nova** (**Winged Love**).

GR.1 GLORY FOR NOLAN AND LATEST EXHIBITION

Paul Nolan looks to have a very smart horse and a live Cheltenham contender on his hands in **Latest Exhibition**, who came out on top in the 2m6f Gr.1 Nathaniel Lacy & Partners Solicitors Novice Hurdle, the opening race of the Dublin Racing Festival yesterday.

The seven-year-old son of **Oscar** settled in third as **Cobbler's Way** (**Oscar**) set a steady early pace. The winner's jumping was slick throughout, but he made a mistake four out and soon came under pressure. The leader still travelled well, while **Longhouse Poet** (**Yeats**) laid down a challenge and the favourite **Fury Road** (**Stowaway**) was still to be asked a question by Davy Russell.

Racing over 2m6f for the first time, **Latest Exhibition** (**Oscar**) saw out the trip well and marked himself down as a live Cheltenham Festival contender, with his likely target either the Gr.1 Albert Bartlett Novices' Hurdle or the Gr.1 Ballymore Novices' Hurdle.

He is the first foal out of the Gr.3 Dawn Run Mares Novice Hurdle winner Aura About You (Supreme Leader), who was also fourth to Hurricane Fly in the Gr.1 Royal Bond Novice Hurdle. She is a full-sister to the bumper winner Windswept Leader and a halfsister to the jumps winners Comehomequietly (King's Theatre), Its Teescomponents (Saddlers' Hall) and Pass It On (Accordion).
